APICS CTSC credential holders gain the skills to effectively manage global supply chain transformation activities that involve their extended enterprise, including the web of suppliers, manufacturers, distributors, retailers and transportation carriers. Why should I earn the CTSC?

To be successful, supply chain professionals need to become transformational leaders who are system thinkers, digitally fluent, and adept at using new generations of tools in all types of supply chains – forward, reverse and circular.

How will I study?

1. ASSESS

- Complete the pre-test to gain baseline knowledge and identify areas for improvement.
- Based on your pre-test scores, the online learning system will recommend the most efficient study plan.

2. STUDY

- Utilize convenient study options: access online study materials via any mobile device, tablet, or computer - 24/7.
- Benefit from microlearning features in the online learning system; focus on smaller content segments for more efficient use of available time.
- Take the chapter quizzes to test knowledge retention, receive feedback and answer rationales and references to the relevant sections in the reading materials.

- Study flashcards to reinforce your memory of key terms, concepts and definitions.

How do I test?

The APICS CTSC exam consists of 150 questions, of which 20 are pre-test questions that do not contribute to the total score but are used for statistical purposes only.

Pre-test questions are continuously introduced and evaluated statistically, as part of an industry best practice for certification program exam development. Pre-test questions appear similar to the scored questions and are randomly distributed throughout the exam. Candidates should answer all exam questions. There is a 3.5 hour time limit for the exam.
